NUTRITION SOCIETY OF NIGERIA (NSN)

Guidelines for the Submission of Extended Abstract for Presentation at the Annual General Meeting (AGM) and Scientific Conference (SC) of NSN

- 1. Extended abstract should be in line with the **theme** and **sub-themes** of the scientific conference.
- 2. The abstract should be typed in **Microsoft Word document** of not more than 2 pages of A4 paper size.
- 3. Line spacing should be **1.5 points** but **single** (**1.0**) line spacing can be used for **tables** if necessary.
- 4. **Times New Roman** and font size **12** should be used.
- 5. The page margins should be set at **Normal** (Top = 2.35cm, Bottom = 2.54cm, Left = 2.54cm and Right = 2.54cm).

The extended abstract should be written using the following outline:

Theme/sub-theme: Indicate the conference Theme or sub-theme your abstract is addressing.

Title: State the Title of the paper.

Name of Author (s): State the Surname, Initials of author(s), indicating the affiliations of individual

authors using figures in superscript. Asterisk the corresponding author's name

only. E.g. *Ola, I.O.¹, and Ideh A.I. ²

Affiliation of Author (s): State the Name of Organization/Institution of author(s) following the order

of the figure in superscript.

E.g. ¹Department of Nutrition and Dietetics, Federal University of

Agriculture, Abeokuta.

²Department of Human Nutrition, University of Ibadan.

Email and phone number of corresponding author, Indicating the corresponding author with an asterisk, e.g. *Corresponding author, e-mail:

olaio@gmail.com, +2348011774456

Keywords: Provide maximum of four (4) keywords

Highlights

This should contain a short collection of bullet points that capture the novel results of your research as well as new methods that were used during the study (if any). Include a maximum of 3 bullet points (maximum 85 characters, including spaces, per bullet point).

E.g.

- Food consumption score was associated with hypertension
- Most mothers had inadequate intakes of fat, fibre and most micronutrients
- Two-thirds of the mothers ate below the minimum dietary diversity

BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES:

This section should contain a brief background and objective of the study to show the gap in knowledge that author(s) seeks to fill.

MATERIALS AND METHOD:

The methodology of study must be clearly stated.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION:

Results should be briefly described and presented in figures, tables, etc. Number the figures/tables using Aramaic numbers. Brief discussion on the implications of the results should be provided with references. Maximum of two (2) tables and/or figures are allowed.

Table(s) should be presented using the format shown below:

Table 1: Title of the table					

CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATION(S):Conclusion based on the results of the study should be stated. Brief recommendation(s) may be given based on the conclusion.

REFERENCES

Maximum of 5 references should be cited in-text in **numerical order** using square bracket e.g. [1] and listed in the same numerical order in the **Reference section** according to the format specified in the Nigerian Journal of Nutritional Sciences.
