

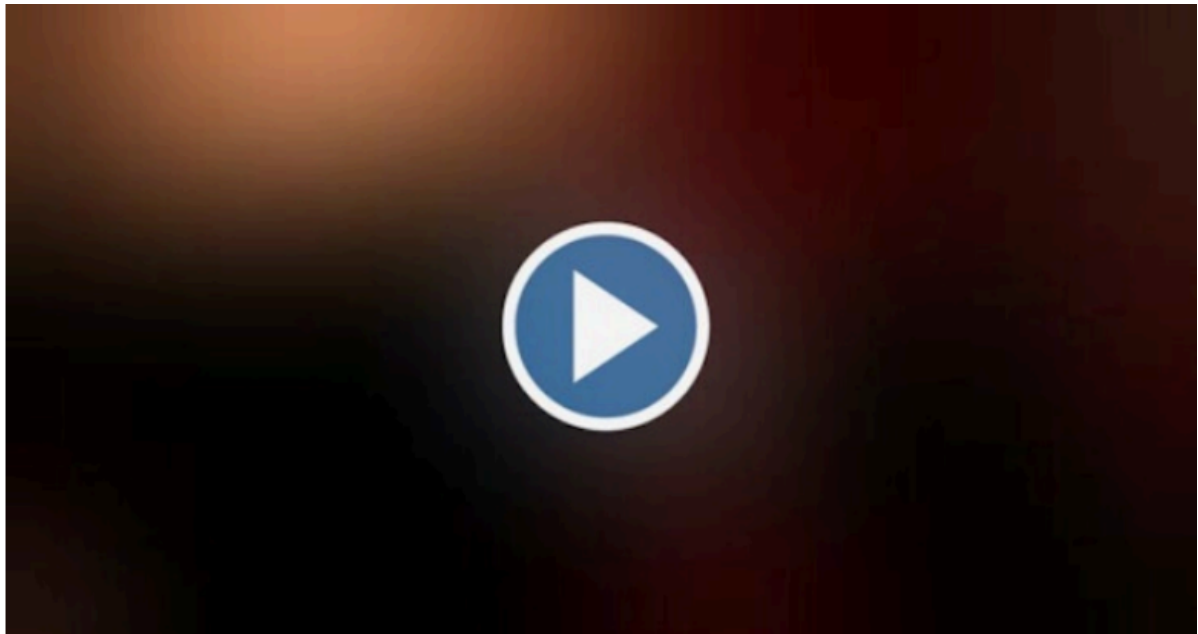

X (formerly Twitter) turned into a war zone:

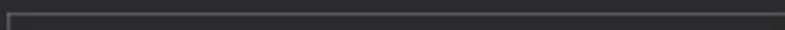


“She’s faking it for sympathy,” critics barked.
